 Parish Church between the Hours of Eight and Twelve in the forenoon We for lawful causes  
 graciously grant this our Licence and Faculty as well to You the Parties contracting as to the Rector, Vicar  
 or Curate of the aforesaid Church, who is designed to Solemnize the Marriage between you in the  
 Manner and Term above Specified according to the Rites of the Book of Common Prayer set forth for  
 that Purpose by the Authority of Parliament Provided always that if in this Case there shall hereafter  
 appear any Fraud suggested to us or Truth suppressed at the time of obtaining this Licence then the Licence  
 to be void and of no Effect in Law as if the same had never been granted And in that case We inhibit  
 all Ministers of any thing of the Premises shall come to their Knowledge that they do not proceed to the  
 Celebration of the said Marriage without consulting us or our ~~Deputy~~ <sup>Deputy</sup> Given
