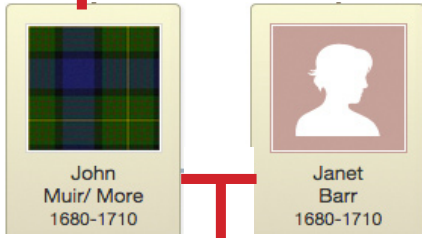


John Muir 1680 and Janet Barr married in Hamilton in 1700

 This is valid only by the sheer number (37) trees who quote the same info...

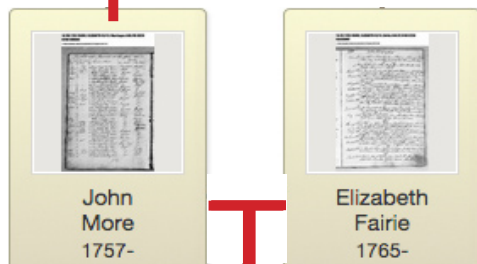

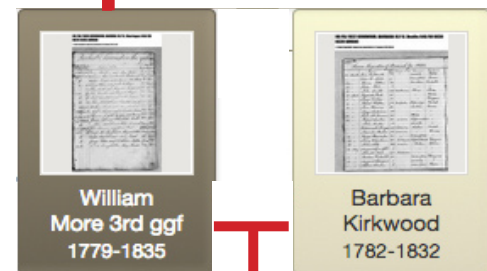
One Birth cert. cites **Walter Muir and Marion Erskine as parents**
 Born Hamilton Lanarkshire



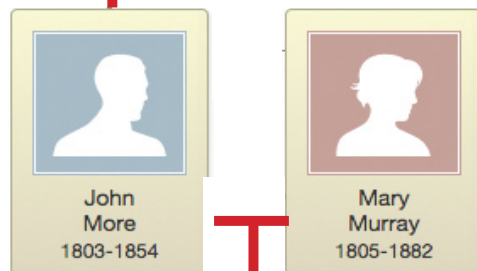
John More 1734 - baptism registry - john Muir 1702 and Mary Meicklejohn have son John in January 29th, 1734 in **Shettleston**. Marriage to Ann Mitchell in Glasgow, Lk on June 15, 1752.



2 Birth records cited - first is **way** out. Second, date and name(John) are right, but no mother. - **Cambuslang** 1757.
 Marriage - Aug. 3, 1781 to Elizabeth Fairie - **Govan** - parish (shots?)



Birth, **Govan** Marriage certif - June 6, 1800, son of John & Eliz fairie, Marriage register: William/**Barbra**, Death certif 1835 - **Govan** - "inflammation"

Baptism (lists parents)- Aug 14, 1803 - **Renfrew**, Scotland (parents William and Barbara - Married Mary Moore in **Bridgeton**, Glasgow, August 27, 1827 - also many sources for Mary Murray - including a grave at Batteau Hill cemetery in **Duntroon**.
