### INSTRUCTIONS.

Applications must be sent to THE SECRETARY, MILITIA DEPARTMENT, OTTAWA.

Of the numbered paragraphs contained in the following form: No. 1 is to be used by an applicant who was an officer in one of the corps raised in Canada, and who served in South Africa; No. 2, by an applicant who enlisted in one of those corps; No. 3, by an applicant who was not in one of those corps, but who otherwise served with the British Forces in South Africa; No. 4, by an applicant who was an officer in one of the corps which were raised in Canada, but which did not reach South Africa before the close of the War; and No. 5, by an applicant who enlisted in one of the last mentioned corps. Unused paragraphs should be crossed by the applicant.
